You may be able to earn a degree or certificate in one of the health care careers below FREE! The Kansas Promise Act Scholarship was created by the Kansas Legislature to provide scholarships for students enrolled in educational programs that will lead to careers in high demand and critical need fields – including health care. After completing their selected program, scholarship recipients must live and work in Kansas for a minimum of two consecutive years.
